

### **VOLUNTEER POSITION:**

Short-term flexible internships are available at Canterbury Baptist Church. These roles provide opportunities to grow as disciples of Jesus, develop gifts, gain experience and serve God in our community. They can be completed over a shorter period of time depending on availability.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Canterbury Baptist Church are creating 'win-win' opportunities for those who want to develop their gifts and calling in an urban, diverse and missional setting. 'Win-win' in the sense that the opportunity will benefit both the development and experience of the interns whilst also assisting the church greatly in its mission and life.

We value each of our interns, grateful for what they bring, but also conscious of their well-being and growth. Our approach to creating tailor-made programmes involves looking at each individual's calling and gifting and seeking to provide hands-on experience in a variety of appropriate areas. Alongside exploring practical experience, the programmes place a large focus on personal development, with 1-on-1 mentoring and group theological training being provided.

Canterbury Baptist Church is a diverse, fast-growing Church that is lively and informal. On usual Sundays, you can expect 150 adults and 30 children.

# INTERNSHIPS FLEXIBLE START/END



#### **PROGRAMME:**

Programmes are designed individually for each intern and the skills and calling they possess. However, there is some overlap in how each internship is organised. Each intern will be given a mentor to meet with, who will identify areas of growth and seek to provide guidance to aid development. Theological education will be offered, depending on the intern's interest up to two modules depending on the length of the programme, Module examples include areas such as biblical interpretation, biblical theology, Christian ethics and applied theology, church history, children and youth, worship, New and Old Testament studies, and more. Depending on the duration of the internship, there may be opportunities to attend a conference in an areas of interest.

#### TIME COMMITMENT:

We understand that for many people, time is a struggle, which is why we provide flexible options to fit around the life God has already given you. Typically for a full-time internship, you would be expected to be available to volunteer for 32 hours a week. For a part-time internship, we would be looking for 10 hours. The above are examples. Our heart is to invite you into a sustainable commitment. As part of your hours, you would be expected to regularly attend the Sunday morning services from 10:30am-12:00pm.

# **ACCOMMODATION AND COST:**

Except in rare instances, you would be expected to provide your own accomodation. If you cannot do this and would still like to join the programme, please let us know. The role is voluntary and without remuneration, but we do offer training expenses depending on the length of the internship.
